Emergency Preparedness & Response

I. Purpose

This procedure shall define emergency response systems for notification, initiating response, identifying potential accidents and emergency situations, and preventing or mitigating impacts.

II. Definitions

<u>Emergency</u> – An unforeseen combination of circumstances that call for immediate action.

<u>Preparedness</u> – To work out the details/plan of action in advance <u>Response</u> – Action taken to control a specific occurrence

III. Responsibility

The Environmental Manager shall be responsible for:

- Reviewing and updating of the environmental spill reporting and response plans
- Coordinating and documenting environmental spill reporting and response plan testing.

The Safety Manager shall be responsible for:

- Reviewing and updating of the safety emergency preparedness and response plans
- Coordinating and documenting safety emergency preparedness and response plan testing, and amending the procedures based on the test results.
- Coordinating resources, training and response actions to mitigate and prevent emergencies
- Coordinating and obtaining outside support services as part of the facility Emergency Response Plan.
- Reviewing and updating the response plan after an actual emergency, corrective actions will be documented in the Corrective/ Preventive action system.

TRAINING

The mill trains appropriate personnel in the provisions of the emergency preparedness and response plans.

MAINTENANCE

The emergency preparedness and response plans are periodically reviewed and updated by the owner. In addition, the plans will be reviewed after the occurrence of accidents or emergency situations.

TESTING

The mill tests certain emergency preparedness and response plans, where practical, a minimum of every 3 years. Such tests shall be documented.
